A work-in-progress meeting was held on the above referenced date with the above attendees. The following items were discussed:

- 1. <u>Deck Coating</u>: Mr. Persampiere requested the Contractor inspect the color difference between the balcony and walkway coatings to determine if there is a significant variance. It was also discussed that the new coating will have high sheen for a short period of time and once the coating weathers over a few weeks it will become more dull in appearance.
- 2. <u>Project Schedule</u>: Mr. Douglass provided updated project schedules and reviewed the general status of the project for each Association.
- 3. <u>Budget</u>: Mr. Longman said he updated the project budget and believes that the SCG 2 project will likely go over budget due to the amount of concrete damage on the walls. He said that the SCG 3 project will likely come-in within the original budget.
- 4. <u>Man Power</u>: Mr. Douglass said he still plans to bring an additional 2 men to the project to assist with painting and deck coating at SCG 3.
- 5. Walkway Closure: Mr. Douglass said the next walkway closure is scheduled for SCG 2 center building which is scheduled for Oct. 4-15.
- 6. <u>Window Removal</u>: Mr. Douglass said he is waiting for the change order to be signed to remove the windows at Units 209 and 309 at SCG 2.
- 7. North Wall 01 stack SCG 2: Mr. Longman said he inspected the North wall at the 01 stack at SCG 2 and there is extensive concrete damage. Mr. Douglass said SPEC intends to wait until the walkway work is complete before starting the repair work at the North wall.

- 8. <u>06 Stack Exploratory</u>: Mr. Douglass said he is still planning on removing drywall at Units 106 and 206 at SCG 2 to determine the condition of the block walls before work starts on that stack. Ms. Setzer will notify owners.
- 9. North Tower tucco: Mr. Douglass said that AAT Restoration will replace the stucco at the North stair tower at SCG 2. Because the texture is non-conventional with the rock finish, Mr. Douglass proposed performing the work on at time and material basis.
